



Replacement Bin procedure

In 1992 a policy was introduced to charge residents for bins which were either wilfully damaged or stolen. The charge was not applied for bins that were replaced due to damage from normal wear and tear.

- As of February 2011, the price for replacement bins which are wilfully damaged or stolen will be £25
- This relates to all black/grey and green lidded bins only.
- Brown lidded bins used on the garden waste scheme, and blue boxes used on the glass recycling scheme should be replaced free of charge
- Bins which split through normal wear and tear or which are damaged by the authority should continue to be replaced free of charge.
- The Head of Neighbourhood Services or Waste Services Manager can waive the replacement bin charge in exceptional circumstance
